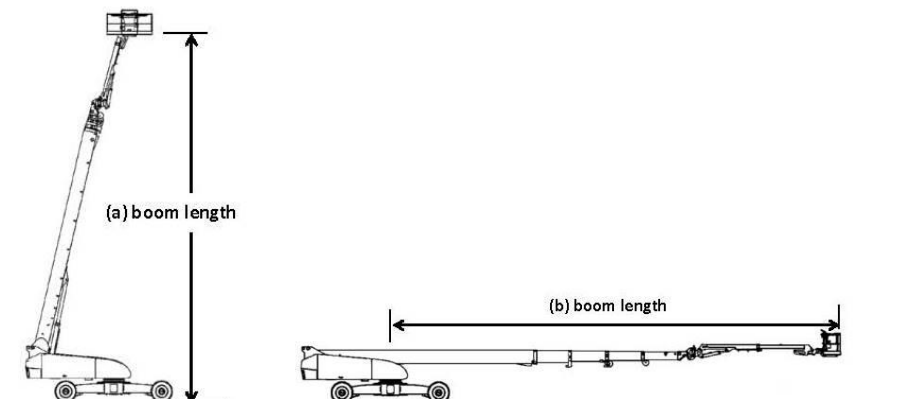

Notes:

- 1) Note: a vertical lift with a jib (i.e. a hinged, luffing member) is classed as a boom type EWP.
- 2) The boom length of an elevating work platform is the greater of:
 - a) The vertical distance from the floor of the platform to the support surface at its maximum height; or
 - b) The nominal reach, measured horizontally, from the centre point of rotation to the outer edge of the platform in its most extended position.



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
